Three level – Practitioner (2 years in emergency management - could be volunteers, interns, entry level), Experienced (3-7 years, Bachelor's contributions, mentored, training, exercises), Professional (8 years experience)

It is hoped that the credential will assist hiring, promotional, pay increase

Right now, no fees for credentialing.

There is an online credential that goes from Practitioner to Professional.

Training support and compliance from the CalOES website. EM Course resources. All course curriculum resides there.

www.csti.org – can set up your own account and it will track courses. Click “Register”

There is a refresher element – probably every 5 years.

Paid vs volunteer – should not affect credentialing
